S.E.E.S is a Student Engagement in the Environment and Science, that will engage students for all parts of the world, to educate and question the world we live in today regarding important issues of sustainability, our environment and the science behind some of it.

The conference will be held at UWCAd, and invited colleges include local schools from Trieste and Monfalcone, as well as all other European UWCs.

At the the conference there will be guest speakers discussing various topics, and **workshops** held involving all participants. These include a '**Trashion Show**', in which students will be creatively inspired to create clothing out of waste and recycled materials, '**60 Second Solutions**' that will encourage students to develop their own sustainable solution to issues, and a '**World Wide Exhibition**', where student from all corners of the world will present the problems presented regarding this theme in their home countries. This is just a taster of what there will be over the **two - day conference**, but it will also be an excellent opportunity to visit the college, and interact with all of the students.

We would ask of you to send a delegation of about **6 students** to come and participate, accommodation will be in the nearby **campsite**.

It would be much appreciated if you are interested, that you apply as soon as possible, as **it is required for participants to create a video over the summer, involving any issues in their home towns for the 'World Wide Exhibition'**.
